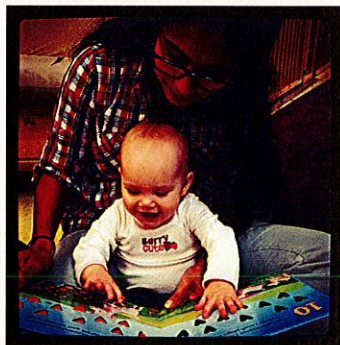

- ☞ Identify our own feeling

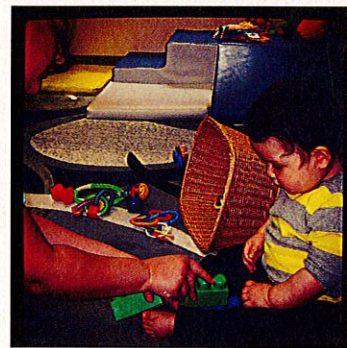

We learn to:

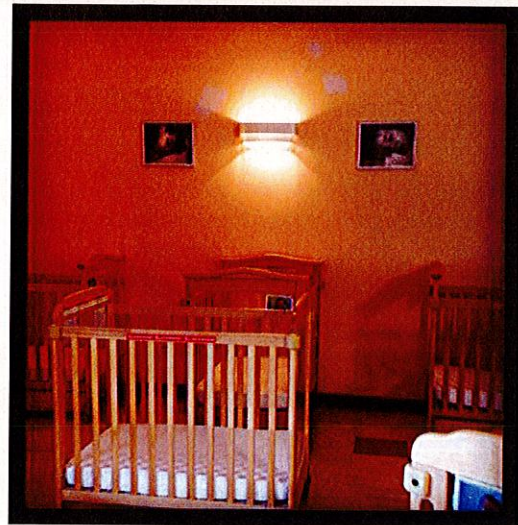
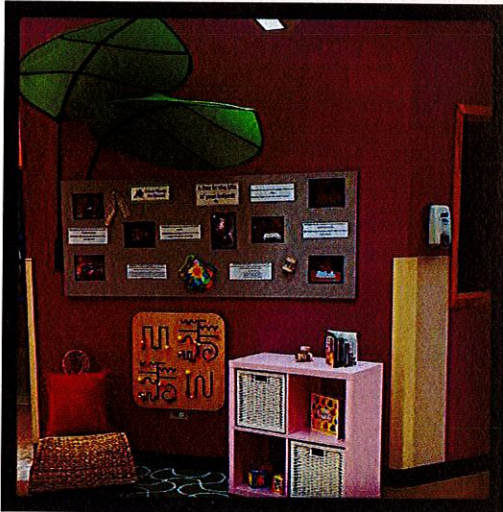
- ☞ Use our senses to explore the properties of an object
