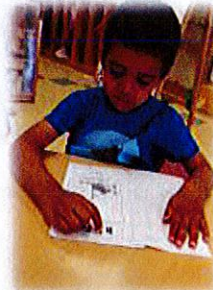

Handwriting Without Tears and "My Work Journal"

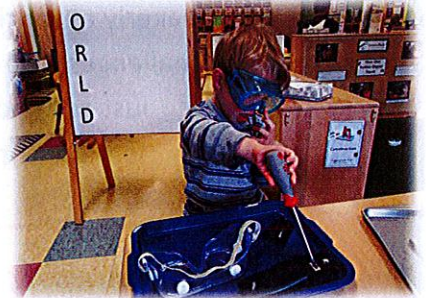
